Letter from the CEO

When given the opportunity to lead JustUs Health in April of 2019, I knew two things: the organization had been through a lot of change, and its future had incredible potential to keep improving lives. I knew that our team of helpers and healers, with a legacy of leading the fight against HIV and LGBTQ health disparities for decades, had the right mix of expertise and passion to continue making a difference for our community. I also knew much was at stake if we didn't.

Our work to support the health of LGBTQ people and others at risk of or living with HIV means we see up close the real-life impact that health disparities have on our community. We see those struggling with mental health issues caused by bigotry-induced trauma. We see the fear on people's faces when they contemplate the need for elder care in a long-term care center. We see the higher rates of stress and illness caused by lack of adequate healthcare, housing, and employment. Seeing all this causes us to act and to make the biggest impact we can, in concert with partners and allies.

Simply put, JustUs Health exists because injustice exists. We know that building a healthy community starts with building healthy people and building healthy people means supporting who they are as a whole person. We work to heal our clients and our community from the inside out.

Much of what we do is what we've done for years. We are still on the front lines in the fight to end HIV by serving more Minnesotans with HIV than any other organization. We are still educating thousands of healthcare professionals with innovative and one-of-a-kind LGBTQ health disparity research. We are still working to give LGBTQ Minnesotans and those living with HIV the tools and support they need to get and stay healthy. We are still at City Hall and the State Capitol fighting for laws that ensure our entire beloved community feels safe, healthy, and can thrive.

Living our values also means doing new work and doing our work differently. In 2019, we launched a three-year strategy to not only strengthen the impact of our existing work but expand our work to serve even more in our community and to truly transform health care systems to work better for those we serve. We are also on an intentional path to more deeply commit to dismantling racism on all fronts.

You're reading this Annual Report because you are part of this work and for that we thank you. Woven throughout the programmatic updates in this Report are the names of the thousands of individuals, families, and organizations that make this work possible—that make JustUs Health possible. Thank you for being with us and for being part of health equity for LGBTQ people and people with HIV.

The Minnesota AIDSLine responded to **2,196 contacts** via phone, online chats, texting, email or drop-in visits.

HIV Prevention

We know that having access to new syringes keeps people healthy and saves lives. At JustUs Health's Mainline Syringe Exchange these are offered free of charge. By offering a judgement free, affirming space, the Mainline Syringe Exchange prevents HIV, Hepatitis C, abscesses, and blood poisoning. Mainline even offers Narcan which can prevent life-threatening overdoses.

JustUs Health acts as a first touch point for clients who are so often made to feel ashamed and unwanted in traditional healthcare or service settings. We provide information and resources in a way that shows our deep respect and care for everyone that walks through the doors. No matter where they are in their journeys, everyone deserves dignity, safety, and compassion.



JustUs Health distributed **10,404 condoms**, **217,742 unused needles**, collected and disposed of **242,523 used needles** resulting in **111.4% return rate.**

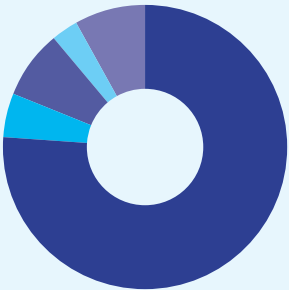

JustUs Health brings LGBTQ and HIV-positive aging adults to the forefront and out from the shadows.



Case Management

JustUs Health's Case Management services provided care planning and coordination to **464 individuals** living in the Twin Cities Metro Area as well as those living in and around Duluth.



- **95%** of case managed clients had health insurance as of December 2018, greatly increasing the likelihood they will access and maintain needed medical care.
- **99%** of case managed clients had documentation of having seen a provider within the last six months as of December 2019.
- **95%** of case managed clients with clinically confirmed lab values had suppressed HIV viral loads as of December 31, 2018 which is higher than the state's viral suppression rate for those living with HIV.

In 2019 JustUs Health provided emergency financial assistance to **1,691 people** and issued **5,362 payments**, including:

- **2413 food certificates**
- **594 payments** for health care insurance, copays and other medical expenses not covered by insurance

- **20 payments** for rental application fees
