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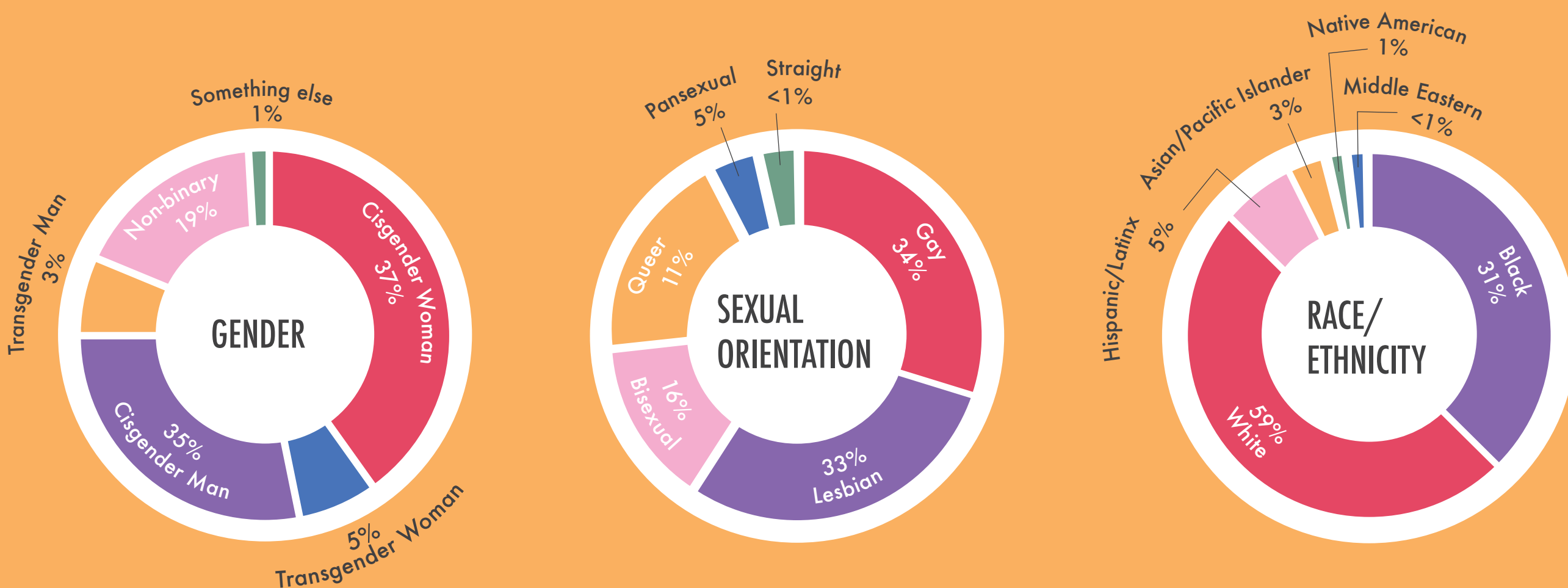


BIPOC LGBTQ Health Access and Experience

Rainbow Health Minnesota's Voices of Health survey is the only annual LGBTQ community health and wellness survey in Minnesota.

In 2021, **1,341** Minnesotans completed the Voices of Health survey. 40% of all LGBTQ respondents were Black, Indigenous, people of color (BIPOC). This snapshot highlights the experiences of BIPOC LGBTQ Minnesotans.

Food Security

57% of BIPOC respondents worried their food would run out before they got money to buy more

53% of BIPOC respondents ran out of food before they got money to buy more

Experiencing Anti-LGBTQ Behavior

84% experienced anti-LGBTQ behavior in the past 12 months

64% have ever been verbally abused or harassed because they were LGBTQ

26% have ever been physically attacked or threatened because they were LGBTQ

Homelessness

13% of BIPOC respondents were homeless (including couch surfing or living in a car) at the time they took the survey

58% had ever experienced homelessness in their lifetime
